We have been finally been blessed with beautiful weather after a very long winter. Our classes have been getting outside to play, go on walks, and eat snacks or meals as much as they can. We will be bringing in an in-house field trip each month in addition to going off-site this summer.



Clothing

Please make sure your child has extra clothing appropriate for warm weather in their cubbie and a long sleeve shirt or sweatshirt here daily. Per policy we also require that children wear closed-toe shoes or sandals with straps to school. This is to ensure that **they** stay safe while playing in the woodchips, running, riding bikes, etc.



Sunscreen

We still have a few students that do not have sunscreen. Please send an unopened, stick or lotion sunscreen for your child, as soon as possible, if you have not done so already. We are unable to except spray sunscreens due to the risk of exposure they pose for staff and other children. Our teachers try to get the students outside as much as possible during the day, which means a minimum of 2 hours a day in the sunshine, weather permitting.



Water Wednesdays



Water Wednesday will begin on June 14. Please have your child dressed for water play when you bring them in the morning with clothing on top. They will also need to have their sunscreen applied. Send a change of clothing as well for them to change into before lunch and rest.

There will be a short reception following. If you will be taking your child home early that day, please let the teachers know ahead of time.
